

DAY 1 **ARRIVE LONDON**
Arrive at London Heathrow Airport where you will be met by an England Rugby Travel representative and transferred to your accommodation for a four night stay.

DAY 2 **LONDON**
After breakfast you will have your first training session of the tour. Return to your hotel for lunch before taking an open top bus ride around London viewing all the famous sites such as Buckingham Palace, Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament.

DAY 3 **LONDON MATCH DAY ONE**
